

Morehart Murphy Subaru Mountain Bike Race: Need to know information:
Monday, May 28th, 2023

- If you registered on or before May 1st you will receive your bib number in the mail. If you are a local rider (zip codes 81301, 81302, 81303, 81122, 81137, or 81326), International rider, or registered after May 1st, you will pick up your bib number at Chapman Hill located at 500 Florida Rd, Durango from 1pm to 7pm on Friday May 26th. If you have a registration question, please contact registration@ironhorsebicycleclassic.com as soon as possible.
- Number plates **MUST** be zip or twist tied to your hand bars in a **flat position**. Not having the plate properly mounted may result in incorrect timing. **Do not bend or curve the plate. Please see the pictures below.**
- The Start/Finish line will be located at Durango Mesa Park (1666 Ewing Mesa Rd). Please drive slowly on the road to the venue as it is private property and horses are in the area. **Category start times are posted on our website** and subject to slight variations. Be at the start/finish area 30 mins before your scheduled race start time.
- The course is a lap style that has a combination of two track and single track.
- The course will be marked on May 24th, 2023. Course alterations may take place due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances. NEW Course for 2023 will be released shortly with new trailers built in March on Durango by World renowned [progressive trail design](#) **Course Maps will be released ASAP.**
- Riders can receive feed zone support (**not provided by event**) directly after the start/finish area as riders lap through.
- **When on course please be aware of the possibility of people entering the trails as the course is restricted but not closed.** - There will be course marshal's on the course and Emergency Medical Personnel in the area. If you see an injured rider, or an issue with the course please alert a marshal or staff at the start/finish.

- If you have to drop out of the race please alert the Officials at the Start/Finish, we do not want to have a search party out looking for you if there is not a need.

Prizes (checks) for all riders will be sent in the mail two weeks after the event, if you have not received it in three weeks email us. There will be no prize distribution at the event with the exception of the Junior 14 and under categories.

Thank you for being a part of our event. We encourage all participants to take in what our region has to offer. Please keep in mind an event that has lasted this long has done so because of the support from our participants, volunteers, sponsors, law enforcement and community. We are happy to have you here.
